Spotlight: Memorial Day History

The Civil War claimed more lives than any conflict in U.S. history, requiring the establishment of the country's first national cemeteries. By the late 1860s Americans in various towns and cities had begun holding springtime tributes to these countless fallen soldiers, decorating their graves with flowers and reciting prayers.

In 1966 the federal government declared Waterloo, New York, the official birthplace of Memorial Day. Waterloo—which had first celebrated the day on May 5, 1866—was chosen because it hosted an annual, community-wide event, during which businesses closed and residents decorated the graves of soldiers with flowers and flags.

In 1971 Memorial Day was declared a federal holiday. (By this point the world wars and all soldiers in general had been included in the remembrance.) Cities and towns across the United States host Memorial Day parades each year, and some Americans visit cemeteries and memorials and place flowers on the graves of the fallen.

The Word of God encourages us to be thankful people, remembering God's goodness to us. Those who have fought and died for our country's freedom are a living example of Christ and the love of God put into action. It's good to remember.
